Girls Inc. undoubtedly will reach their goals with the support of our community and the excellent leadership of their Board of Directors, staff, and volunteers.

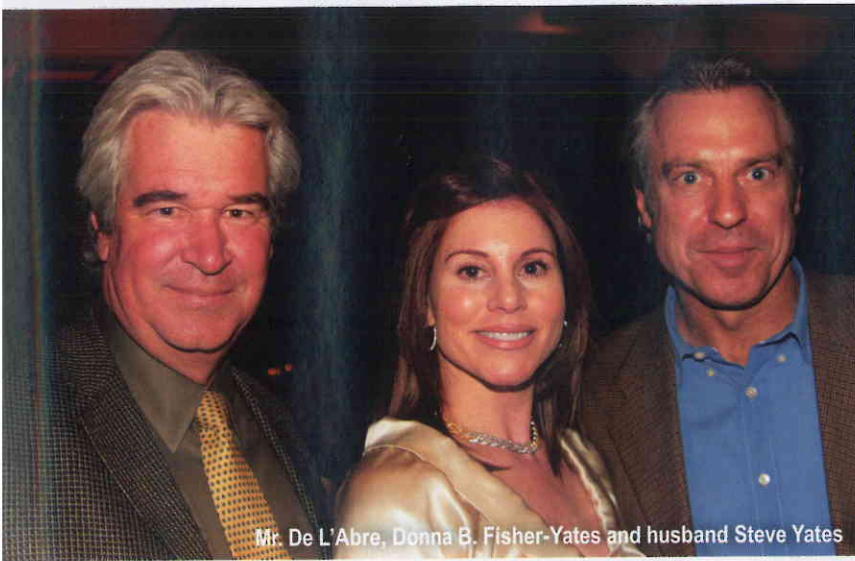

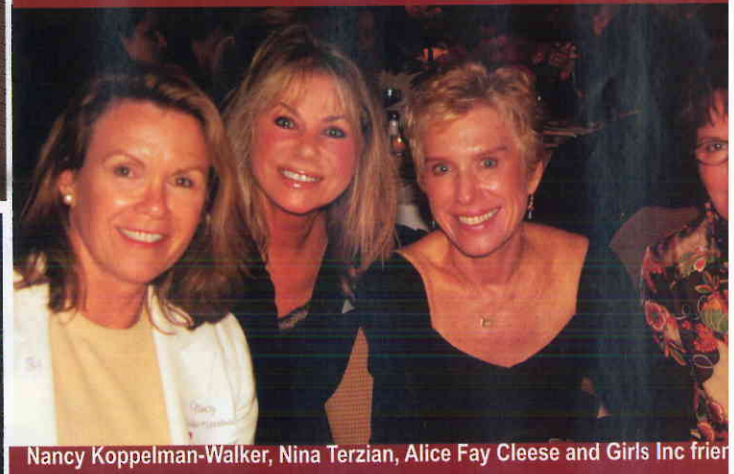
